

QUICK REFERENCE GUIDE



ZONED PARKING PERMITS

Available to purchase for faculty and staff working at 1650. Can only be used in the lot printed on the front of their permit.

Exceptions include: Use with Rover Permit to park in another lot, stickers allowing staff to move between lots due to business need.

RESERVED PARKING

Staff may purchase a designated parking space in U Lot at the current rate of \$1300/year.

UNM Departments can also purchase reserved spaces (current rate is \$1243/year).



LEFE PARKING

PATS encourages and rewards the use of Low Emissions and Fuel Efficient (LEFE) vehicles. If your vehicle qualifies, you can visit PATS' main office to apply for a free LEFE sticker, which will give exclusive use of specially-reserved parking spaces in U Lot (cannot be used in LEFE spots in other lots).

The spaces are first-come first-serve and are strictly reserved for those displaying their LEFE sticker and valid U Lot parking permit. The spaces have the same exclusivity status as Reserved spaces and are not subject to the 3:45 p.m. rule. Vehicle registration is required for each vehicle and you must not have an outstanding balance on your parking account.

HOURLY PARKING



Pay station parking spaces available

for \$1.75 per hour. All hourly parking is purchased using pay stations that accept VISA and Mastercard.



ROVER PERMITS

Departments with administrative or

technical personnel with business around campus to provide services or attend meetings may apply for an organizational rover permit. Due to their nature, the issuance of rover permits is tightly regulated to avoid misuse. Organizations must provide sufficient justification in their application that there is no other solution for personnel to adequately perform their job function without a rover permit.

U Rover Permits will allow users to park in any other permitted lot on campus for up to 4 hours.

ADA/HANDICAPPED PARKING



If you have been personally issued and possess a current and valid ADA or handicapped placard OR if you are transporting an individual who has been personally issued and possesses a current and valid ADA or handicapped placard, you can park in any designated ADA/Handicapped parking space. If those spaces are full, with the display of the valid placard you may also park in any regular zone parking space or in any pay station space.

MOTORCYCLE

motorcycle permits are available for purchase for \$70 per year. If you purchase a vehicle parking permit from PATS, we will give you a motorcycle permit for FREE. All motorcycle permits must be purchased in person at the PATS office.

- ◆ Bring in the valid registration for your motorcycle.
- ◆ If receiving the FREE motorcycle permit (in addition to purchased car permit) the motorcycle



must be registered in your name.
